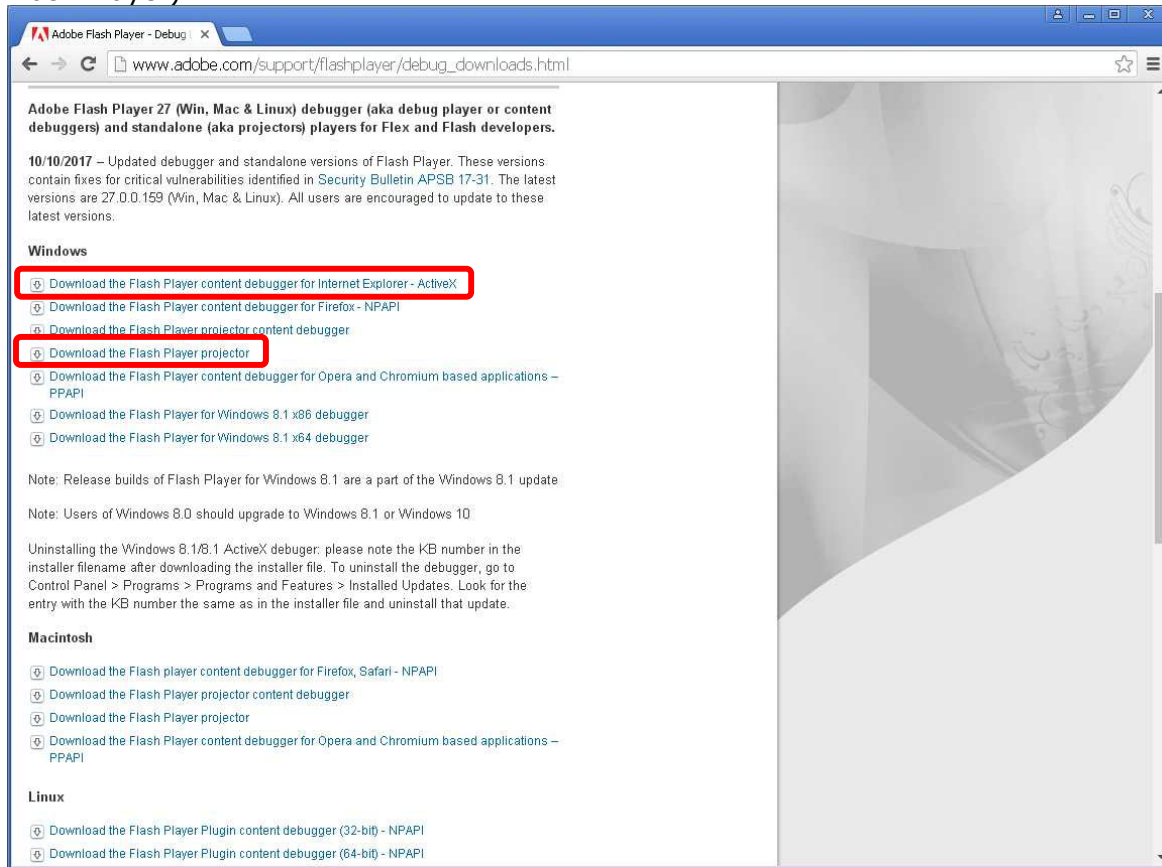


## How to Install Flash Player

- Go to this web page:

and scroll down to the download links for the "ActiveX" control and the "projector" file (Shockwave Flash Player):

- Save the downloaded projector executable file (Shockwave Flash Player) in a convenient location (eg C:\Program Files\Shockwave\) and associate swf files with it by right-clicking on an swf file and selecting:  
File -> Open with -> (then browse to the location of the Shockwave Player executable and select the option to always open these files with that application. swf files will now always launch with the Shockwave Player simply by double-clicking.
- In order to have swf files play within another application such as PowerPoint, simply run the installer file for the Flash "ActiveX" control. If this is not done, then when attempting to open a PowerPoint presentation which contains links to swf files, an error message will be displayed like this: "Some controls in this presentation may not activate. They may not be registered on this computer"
